Leweston School is delighted to offer Performing Arts Scholarships for pupils entering Year 9 or Year 12. The Scholarship is worth 20% of the full boarding fees.

Leweston fosters interest in all aspects of Performing Arts through high-quality teaching, high-profile performance and an excellent foundation in academic music and drama.

Scholarships are awarded to celebrate talent and nurture potential. Scholars must demonstrate exceptional talent in at least two of the following: Musical Theatre, Singing, Drama, Dance. They must be active and enthusiastic and practise their disciplines regularly. They must be punctual and well-prepared and maintain the highest standards of conduct in rehearsal and performance. They will be expected to support the school's productions and concerts.

Candidate's must demonstrate a passion and talent for performing and show their potential to develop. They must have a genuine interest and enthusiasm for drama, dance and/or singing, and show a positive attitude, creative approach and commitment.

Performing Arts Scholars benefit from:

- Access to individual tuition in singing and/or LAMDA
- Participation in relevant choirs, concerts, ensembles and musical and drama productions, at Leweston and other local and national venues
- Input from the Music, Drama and Boarding staff to establish practice routines, and reasonable adjustments to the academic timetable
- A 'Mentor' from the Performing Arts staff, with whom they can discuss their academic and performance needs, as well as plan for further and higher musical education
- The opportunity to be involved in masterclasses and lectures from visiting professionals and to attend regular concert and theatre trips organised by the department
